



In the admin for the both the Tipper and tippee these data points will be there. Purchase Date amount and Nuggiezz conversion number. This is one section. The other section has Total tips available, Tipped Name, Date of Tip, Amount of tip. There is a Cash out section also. It says Cashout, amount of nuggiezz to cash out. and enter to send an email to use to cahs out. This will be the data available.

You're essentially defining three views in the admin: purchases, tips, and cashouts, each with specific fields visible to both the tipper and the tippee.^[1]

Purchases section (Tipper admin)

For each Nuggiez purchase you'll show:

- Purchase date.
- Purchase amount in USD.
- Nuggiez conversion number (tokens received for that purchase).

This is backed by the `token_purchases` table plus the wallet balance, and gives the tipper a clear purchase history and how many Nuggiez they got each time.^[2]

Tips section

For the tipper admin:

- Total tips available (current Nuggiez wallet balance in tokens and optionally USD equivalent).
- Tipped name (which streamer they tipped).
- Date of tip.
- Amount of tip (in tokens and optionally USD at 2.00 per token).

For the tippee/streamer admin:

- Total tips available (their current USD tip balance available to cash out).

- Tipper name (optional but nice), date of tip, amount of tip, and cumulative totals over filters like last 7/30 days.^[1]

All of this comes from the `tips` table plus `token_wallets` (for tippers) and `streamer_balances` (for streamers).

Cashout section (Streamer admin)

For streamers (tippee side):

- A Cash out action.
- Input: “Amount of Nuggiezz to cash out” or, better, “Amount in USD to cash out” (since the balance is tracked in USD).
- When they submit, the system:
 - Validates they meet the 50 USD minimum and have enough available balance.
 - Creates a `cashout_requests` record.
 - Sends BudVizion an email (or internal notification) with the cashout details so you can pay them.

In the UI, after submission, show the calculated fee and net USD they’ll receive so expectations are clear.^[3]
